BEVEL LINE SANITARY SEWERS STURGEON CREEK TO MERSEA ROAD B

The Municipality of Leamington is considering the construction of a sanitary sewer / sewage forcemain / pumping station system to service the properties on Bevel Line between Sturgeon Creek and Mersea Road B. The purpose of this project is to address a pollution problem due to runoff from old and faulty septic tank weeping / bed systems affecting the water quality of Sturgeon Creek. This project began in 2009 as a Local Improvement, but was tabled after Council resolved that administration should review the project cost and find opportunities to reduce the cost assessed to individual landowners.
