## NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF A SCREENING

The Leamington Pollution Control Centre is located at 435 Seacliff Drive East and treats residential and commercial wastewater collected from the Municipality of Leamington.

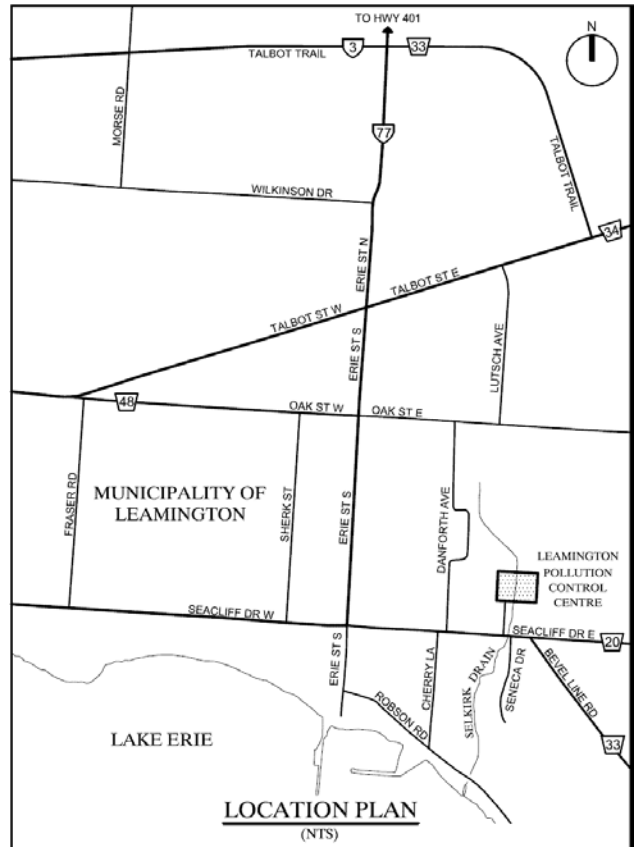
As part of improvements to operation and treatment practices at the Leamington Pollution Control Centre (PCC), the Municipality of Leamington will be installing a new standby power generator, for which a Municipal Class EA has been completed. The new generator will allow the Leamington PCC to provide primary and secondary treatment in the event of a power outage, preventing untreated wastewater from being discharged into Lake Erie.

The Municipality of Leamington is proposing to use the standby generator to participate in GenSet Resource Management's Wholesale Embedded Generation Program, which involves generating and selling power to the Province of Ontario during peak demand times, thereby helping reduce Ontario's demand for electricity. The standby generator would not be used for this purpose during PCC power outages.

This proposed use of the generator requires a screening conducted in accordance with the Ontario Ministry of the Environment's *Environmental Screening Process for Electricity Projects*. The Screening, which has been completed, concluded that there are no significant negative effects associated with the generator's proposed use.
