

2010 SUMMER STUDENT EMPLOYMENT STUDENT LOTTERY

The **Municipality of Leamington** annually hires students during the months of May to September. The rate of pay is between \$11.26 and \$12.38 (2010 rates under review) depending on the position. Summer student applications will be available **ONLINE** at www.learmington.ca and can be printed off and/or can be picked up at municipal offices located at **38 Erie St. North, Leamington, ON**, starting 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, **December 17, 2009** and must be returned/received (no faxes or e-mails or mail-ins) at **38 Erie St. North Corporate Services office by Friday, Feb. 26, 2010 by 4:00 p.m.**

To be eligible for a summer student position an applicant must meet the following qualifications:

- 1.) **Must be a resident of the Municipality of Leamington (except for Lifeguards/ Swim Instructors only).**
- 2.) **Must be at least 16 years of age by May 1, 2010, and**
- 3.) ***Must be in attendance at a Secondary School, University or Community College recognized by the Ontario Ministry of Education.**
- 4.) **If you were employed as a student during the summer of 2009 by the Municipality of Leamington, YOU MUST apply to and be eligible for the lottery in 2010 otherwise you will not be eligible for employment for the summer of 2010.**

***Note:** Attendance at University or Community College requires enrolment in at least three (3) courses per school term.

Eligible applicants who were not previously employed by the municipality in 2009 will be entered into a lottery system for available positions. The draw does not guarantee employment. The order of consideration for these positions will be determined by means of a draw, the results of an interview and availability to work. The following positions will be available:

Kinsmen Recreation Complex:

- Day Camp Co-ordinators and Counsellors (Standard Level First Aid with CPR Level "C" required -**please attach a copy of a current certificate**). Preference given to candidates with HIGH FIVE certification. Weekend and evening shifts may be required.
- Lifeguards/Swim Instructors (**please attach a copy of your qualifications**): Standard Level First Aid with CPR Level "C"; National Lifeguard Service; Red Cross Water Safety Instructor; Lifesaving Society Instructor. Weekend and evening shifts will be required.

Leamington Municipal Marina:

- Maintenance Workers.
- Dockhands (if you possess a Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross Certificate and Standard First-Aid with CPR Level "B" please attach copies of current certificates).

Public Works Department:

- Outside Labourer positions for Parks.
- Outside Labourer positions for Roads.
- Kinsmen Sports Fields Maintenance.

Water Department and Pollution Control Centre

- Outside Labourer positions

Students interested in the above summer positions must apply by obtaining and returning an application **by no later than 4:00 p.m., FRIDAY, February 26, 2010.** Only **one (1)** application may be submitted per person. Applicants will not be formally acknowledged.

Personal information provided is collected under the authority of the Municipal Act 2001, R.S.O. 2001, and will be used to determine eligibility for employment. The Municipality of Leamington is an equal opportunity employer.
