RE: Two arrested for drug offences.

Leamington Police have laid drug charges against one Leamington man and one man from Brampton following an incident yesterday afternoon in Leamington. At approximately 5:00 pm Tuesday afternoon police stopped a suspicious male walking on Garrison Avenue. Through investigation it was learned that there was drug dealing going on at an apartment unit on Garrison. Police attended and Mark McNeil 45 years of age from Brampton jumped out of an apartment window. When he did, he threw a package that contained 27.75 grams of crack cocaine and powder cocaine. In his attempt to flee, he fell to the ground right in front of the officers and was subsequently arrested. Upon arrest he was found in possession of \$1,319 in cash and a set of digital scales.

Police learned that McNeil had been charged on September 18th in Windsor and released on a Recognizance of Bail for the offences of flight from police and possession of a prohibited weapon. One the terms of the bail was that he not attend Windsor or anywhere in Essex County. McNeil was charged with 2 counts of possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking, one count of breach of recognizance.

Daryl Edward Davis 35 of Leamington was charged with two counts of possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking. Both made appearances in court in Windsor today.
