The following are the reportable occurrences for the Leamington Police for the period of February 9th to February 22nd 2010.

Feb 9th – Sometime between 1:00 pm and 6:00 pm a residence on Foster Ave was broken into. A quantity of cash and electronics taken.

Feb 14th – Sometime around 9:00 pm a black leather purse was stolen from an apartment on Russell St.

Feb 16th – Sometime over the weekend Mill St School was broken into.
