MUNICIPALITY OF LEAMINGTON LICENSING PROVISIONS

PLEASE NOTE:

1. A licence issued under the provisions of this by-law shall not be transferable and is valid only in respect of the person or of the premises named therein, except that where two or more persons carry on business as pawnbrokers in partnership in one shop, only one licence is necessary.
2. The issuance or renewal of a licence is not intended and shall not be construed as permission or consent by the Corporation for the holder of the licence to contravene or to fail to observe or comply with any law of Canada or of Ontario or with any by-law of the Corporation.
3. A licence issued under the provisions of this by-law shall be valid for the year for which it was issued only, or for any portion thereof as specified in the licence.
4. All licences shall expire on December 31 of the year for which they were issued, or on any other date specified in the licence.
5. Every licensee shall notify the Municipal Clerk within 6 days of any change in his business or home address.
6. Every issuance is conditional for a period of 90 days following the date on which the licence is issued pending verification of the application for issuance of the licence.
7. Every pawnbroker shall submit the names and resident address of every employee of the business prior to the employee commencing work.
8. Every pawnbroker shall install and maintain a video camera/surveillance system satisfactory to the Municipal Clerk and retain the video tapes for a period of 30 days.
9. Council may suspend or revoke a pawnbroker licence:
 - (a) for any reason that would disentitle the holder to a licence if he were an applicant;
 - (b) where the holder of the licence is in breach of a condition of the licence or of this by-law or has been convicted of an offence pursuant to the Pawnbrokers Act.
