Notice to Consumers

Sewer Surcharge Adjustment

In 2004 the Municipality of Leamington embarked on a Pollution Control Centre (PCC) Master Plan.

The plan identified capital improvements that are required for the Pollution Control Centre to meet Ministry of Environment effluent quality requirements and accommodate cost effective treatment into the future.

Phases 1 and 2 of these capital improvements have been completed, and design work is now complete for the remaining phases 3, 4, and 5 of the upgrade work. These phases will shortly be tendered, and work is expected to be complete in mid 2011.

In order to accommodate this work the municipal sewer surcharge will need to be adjusted to service the capital improvements and maintenance now and in the future.

An interim adjustment has been approved by council for 2009, and the 2009 rates effective January 1, 2009 will be as follows:
