NEXUS Marine:

- A NEXUS Card is designed to expedite the border clearance for low-risk, pre-approved travelers into Canada and the U.S.
- This is a joint Canadian (CBSA) and U.S. (CBP) cooperating venture to simplify border crossings, while enhancing security.
- To become a member, submit an application, either online at www.nexus.gc.ca or mail. Process takes 6-8 weeks.

PROGRAM Benefits:

- If approved in NEXUS, you will receive a membership identification card good for NEXUS air, land and marine ports of entry.
- **Children under the age of 18 are Free** but still need to apply. **At the interview**, all wishing to apply must be present.
- The documents presented to the officer at the enrollment centre have to establish that the adult or adults are the legal guardians.
- Card is good for 5 years, costs only \$50usd/cdn. and the fee is non-refundable.
