

Marriage Licence Requirements

Marriage Licence Fee:

\$135.00 Cash or debit accepted, no personal cheques.

Age:

Applicants must be 18 years of age or over, or parental consent is required

Issuing of Marriage Licence:

Both applicants must sign the application form; however, the Marriage Licence can be issued to one or both of the applicants. When issued to only one of the applicants, the required identification of the absent party must be produced.

Identification Required:

Bring two (2) pieces of valid and original identification from the list below for each person. One piece of identification must include your photo.

Photocopies not accepted. Documents not in English or French must be translated by a certified translator.

Publication of Banns:

Inquire with your clergyman if you need to obtain a Marriage Licence.

Divorce or Annulment:

If divorced in Canada, you will require the original or court-certified copy of the final decree or certificate of divorce (uncertified photocopies not accepted).

If divorced outside of Canada, you will require authorization from the Office of the Registrar General. Contact the Municipal Office, an Ontario lawyer, or visit [Service Ontario](#) to obtain more information.

Marriage Licence Valid:

Licence is valid anywhere in Ontario for a period of three (3) months from the date of issue.

Hours of Issue:

Marriage Licences are issued from 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM, Monday to Friday.
