

Tips For Riders

- Exercise caution when entering and exiting the bus.
- Exact change is required for cash fares; drivers cannot make change.
- Have your fare, pass or transfer ready when boarding the bus.
- When boarding with a stroller, walker, or grocery cart, lock wheels and try and keep the aisle as clear as possible. Please remove children from wagons.
- Priority front seating on Leamington Transit is designated for use as follows:
 - 1) People using wheelchairs or scooters.
 - 2) Persons with disabilities.
 - 3) Children in strollers.

Note: Children in strollers will be accommodated, however, should anyone noted in priority (1) or (2) require the wheelchair area, you will be asked to move to another seat and you may need to fold your stroller.

■ Large articles such as large packages, and sporting equipment may be permitted at the discretion of the transit operator, provided that there is space on the bus, they do not block the aisles or doors and other customers are not inconvenienced. The transit operator is not required to assist with the boarding and unloading of these articles.

■ In line skates, roller skates, and ice skates must be removed before boarding the bus.

■ Shirts and shoes must be worn.

■ For a pleasant and clean environment for all riders, please do not place your feet on bus seats.

■ Dogs on leashes with a muzzle and small non-exotic pets in a small carry cage or enclosure are permitted when carried without danger or offence to other passengers.

■ No smoking on Leamington Transit buses and in bus shelters.

■ No eating or drinking on board the bus.

■ Toxic, flammable and hazardous materials are not allowed on the bus.

Lost and Found

All articles found on our buses are taken to the Lost and Found at Switzer-Carty Transport Inc., 10 Seacliff Drive East, Leamington. Items will be retained for 60 days and then disposed of.

Transfer

On days when both the regular route and summer route are operating, transfers are possible from one route to the other route at designated transfer points as shown on the map and schedule. A transfer must be requested when you pay for your fare on the first bus and can only be used by the person to whom it was issued. Transfers will not be issued to passengers boarding with a previously issued transfer. Transfers are not to be used to board a bus on the same route. The transfer ticket is valid for 2 hours from the date and time punched on the transfer ticket by the bus operator. Please note that the schedule times are estimated only and the buses may be running late due to traffic conditions along the routes. Buses on the intersecting bus route will not wait at transfer points for late buses so transfers are not guaranteed and you may need to wait for the next scheduled bus if a transfer is missed.

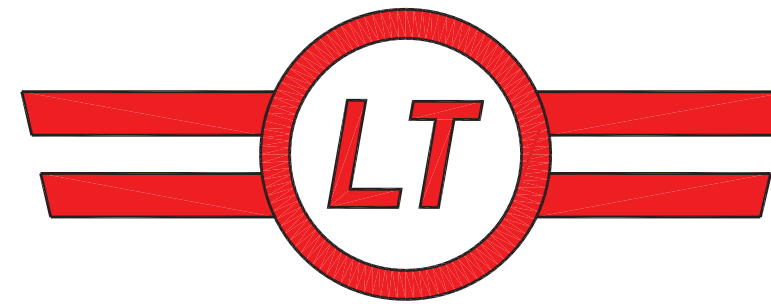

Passes good for 22 rides are available from the driver or at Switzer-Carty Transportation Inc.

Rates for 22 ride passes are \$35 for adults and \$30 for seniors (60 and over).
