

COUNCIL MATTERS

At the Council meeting held on June 11, 2018, Council:

- Received a presentation regarding the Communities in Bloom program;
- Received annual meeting reports for several drainage schemes and appointed Drainage Commissioners;
- Directed that the \$198,346 net cost to build the Pelee/Bevel Sanitary Sewer section north of MH 1-N, relating to the servicing of Bevel Line Villages and Golfwood Lakes subdivisions, be paid for by the Municipality of Leamington and funded from the Infrastructure Reserve;
- Authorized an agreement with M&S Janitorial Service (2002) Ltd. to perform janitorial services at various locations throughout the Municipality from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2020 for the amount of \$220,140 plus HST;
- Received the Windsor Essex Provincial Offences Act (POA) Program 2017 Annual Report;
- Authorized an agreement with the Association of Municipalities of Ontario for the Main Street Revitalization Initiative Grant Program and approved the Mill Street Reconstruction project to receive the Main Street Revitalization Initiative funding;
- Authorized retaining Marianne Love to conduct the review of compensation for Municipal Council, Committee of Adjustment, Leamington Police Services Board and Union Water Joint Board of Management (2018-2022) at a cost of \$5,000 plus HST;
- Directed Administration to investigate a training program for Taxicab Drivers relating to customer service and accessibility needs;

- Received a site plan sketch for the development of 14 multi-residential dwellings, a commercial retail site and the creation of a new municipal right of way for West Side County Road 33 and directed Administration to prepare a final site plan agreement with 2078262 Ontario Ltd. for Council's consideration and approval, subject to the conditions outlined in the Report PLA-20-18;
- Passed a resolution calling upon the Government of Ontario and all political parties to formally grant municipalities the authority to approve landfill projects in, or adjacent to, their communities prior to June 2018; that the approval be required at both the upper-tier and affected lower-tier municipalities; and that the Municipality of Leamington encourage all other municipalities in Ontario to consider this motion calling for immediate Provincial Action;
