

COUNCIL MATTERS

At the Council meeting held on July 23, 2018, a Court of Revision was held regarding the Hooker Drain and the Lebo Creek Drain and the assessment schedules for both projects were confirmed. Following this meeting, Council:

- Adopted the Engineer's report for the Changes in Assessment to the Lebo Creek Drain - Northwest Branch, Hooker Drain and Hooker Drain - Highway 77 Branches of the Hooker Drain - West Branch, prepared by Baird AE with a revision date of May 29, 2018, as well as the Engineer's report for the Changes in Assessment: Hooker Drain and Highway 77 Branches of the Hooker Drain - West Branch, prepared by Baird AE dated May 29, 2018, pursuant to the provisions of the Drainage Act, Section 65 (1, 3 & 4);
- Awarded the Driedger Drain - New Petition drain project to Rivard Excavating Ltd., for the amount of \$138,626.00;
- Approved By-law 42-18 to impose fees to benefitting properties in connection with the Danforth Avenue (Seacliff to Hayward) Sewer Separation Project;
- Provided direction to Administration in regard to the compensation review for Municipal Council, Committee of Adjustment, Leamington Police Services Board and Union Water Supply System Joint Board of Management and the removal of the tax exempt portion of Council remuneration for the 2018-2022 term of Council;
- Authorized the reallocation of \$17,500 in budgeted Community Improvement Plan (CIP) grant funding from the Interior Renovation Grant Stream to the Building Exterior and Façade Improvement Grant stream;
- Accepted the municipal services installed in the MZM Development Phase 1, save and except sidewalks and surface asphalt; the underground services (water and sewer only) installed in the MZM Development Phase 2 and approved the one year maintenance period for the accepted services to begin July 23, 2018;
- Received a report on the Status of Roads for the Hogs for Hospice Event.
