

COUNCIL MATTERS

At the Council meeting held on August 27, 2018, Council:

- Approved additions of properties with heritage potential to Leamington's Register of Heritage Properties with a listed status;
- Authorized an agreement with the owner of 597 Highway 77 to permit two residential dwellings on the property for a period of one year;
- Approved the budget prepared on a full accrual basis of accounting for disclosure in the Municipality's 2018 financial statements;
- Received a presentation regarding an overview of CityWorks and By-law Enforcement; directed Administration to undertake public consultation related to the regulation of window coverings and to commence proactive by-law enforcement in the Uptown as a pilot project and assign a current by-law enforcement officer specifically to this project;
- Directed Administration to implement amendments to the Business Licensing By-law regarding the requirement for a valid Food Handler Certificate Card and the requirement to provide a Master Business Licence from the Province of Ontario, and directed Administration to review the inclusion of a specific category for hotels, motels and Airbnb businesses;
- Amended the Tariff of Fees By-law to include bench & wall ads and penalty box sign ads, and authorized entering into an advertisement agreement with the Leamington Flyers;
- Approved the Terms of Reference and remuneration for the Election Compliance Audit Committee and delegated the authority to select and appointment members to the Clerk;
- Reconsidered a motion from the July 9, 2018 Council meeting regarding the right of first refusal to purchase vacant lands fronting on Talbot Street West and directed that the matter be added to the Closed Meeting agenda for the next Council meeting.
