January 13, 2026 Meeting of Council


Under the authority of Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 284.11 (Veto Powers for By-laws);

The Mayor has decided as follows:

1. The Mayor will not exercise the power to veto the following By-laws, passed at the January 13, 2026, Council meeting:
 - By-law 113-25 being a By-law to provide for the making of an application for the approval to expropriate All Right, Title and Interest (Fee Simple) (Confidential LGL-34-25)
 - By-law 01-26 being a By-law to establish an Administrative Penalty System (LS-19-25)
 - By-law 02-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 668-06 being a By-law to provide for the regulation and registration of dogs
 - By-law 03-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 50-24 being a By-law to provide for the licensing and regulating businesses
 - By-law 04-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 600-05 Respecting the sale and discharge of fireworks
 - By-law 05-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 629-05 being a By-law to regulate the holding of garage sales
 - By-law 06-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 41-22 being a By-law requiring the abatement of interior greenhouse light

- By-law 07-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 840-08 being a By-law to prescribe standards for the maintenance of land
 - By-law 08-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 51-18 being a By-law to regulate noise
 - By-law 09-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 34-10 being a By-law restricting open air fires
 - By-law 10-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 98-25 being a By-law for the Regulation, Protection and Governance of Parks
 - By-law 11-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 70-22 being a By-law prescribing standards for the maintenance and occupancy of all property
 - By-law 12-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 55-22 being a By-law to regulate the size, use, location, construction and alteration of Signs
 - By-law 13-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 63-16 being a By-law to provide for the licensing, regulating and governing of taxicab owners and taxicab drivers
 - By-law 14-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 63-16 being a By-law to regulate traffic and the parking of vehicles
 - By-law 15-26 being a By-law to amend By-law 769-07 to exercise its powers under its “waste management” sphere of jurisdiction
 - By-law 16-26 being a By-law to confirm the proceedings of the Council of the Municipality of Leamington at its meeting held January 13, 2026
2. The Mayoral Direction/Decision provides written notice to approve the above by-law(s).
 3. This Mayoral Direction/Decision comes into effect January 13, 2026.
