## Schedule A

The following conditions must be met and adhered to by the Hauler of Domestic Septic Wastes and/or Grey Waters, to be able to dispose of the material at the Leamington Pollution Control Centre:

1. The Hauler must be licensed by the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change and be in good standing.
2. The Hauler must be approved by The Corporation of the Municipality of Leamington.
3. The Hauler must utilize numbered Septic Waste Transfer Ticket, with the Company's Letterhead.
4. Unless notified and approved by The Corporation of the Municipality of Leamington, the source of hauled waste must NOT be from outside the Municipal limits of Leamington.
5. The Hauler must supply the Leamington Pollution Control Centre with tank truck numbers and capacities and supply a sample of wastewater at the time of unloading each load for pH measurement.
6. The Hauler will be charged a disposal fee which will be amended from time to time. The Hauler will be billed monthly by The Corporation of the Municipality of Leamington for the previous month's fee.
7. The normal disposal hours will be 7:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday to Friday.
8. In order not to impede the biological treatment process at the Leamington Pollution Control Centre, no liquid will be accepted for treatment if it exceeds; 100mg/L (10%) of oil, grease or fat in total of animal origin, or 15 mg/L (1.4%) of oil or grease in total of mineral origin.
9. The Hauler shall provide either a bond, letter of credit or certified cheque in the amount of five hundred dollars in form acceptable to the Municipality; to be held in trust until such time as the Hauler ceases disposing of septic waste at the Pollution Control Centre.
10. The Hauler hereby releases and holds harmless the Corporation its directors, officers, employees, agents and elected or appointed officials, of and from all actions, causes of action, suits, claims and demands of every nature and kind arising out of hauling or disposing of domestic septic waste and/or grey waters at the Leamington Pollution Control Centre.
11. The Hauler shall at all times indemnify and save harmless the Corporation its directors, officers, employees, agents and elected or appointed officials from and against all claims and demands, loss, costs, damages, actions, suits or other proceedings by whomsoever made, brought or prosecuted in any manner based upon, occasioned by or attributable to the hauling or disposing of domestic septic waste and/or grey waters at the Leamington Pollution Control Centre.

12. The Hauler shall obtain and keep in force Commercial General Liability Insurance underwritten by an insurer licensed to conduct business in the province of Ontario which insurance shall include the following:

- a) a limit of liability in the amount of \$2 million per occurrence including but not limited to bodily injury including death, property damage, contractual liability and non-owned automobile;
- b) the Municipality named as an additional insured; and
- c) a provision for cross liability in respect of the named insured.

If requested by the Municipality, a certified true copy(s) of the policy(s) certified by an authorized representative of the insurer shall be provided.

13. The Hauler's permit privileges will be revoked if the aforementioned conditions are not adhered to or for non-payment of any account when due.
