



Mayoral Direction/Decision **(Part VI.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001)**

Decision Number: MD-019-2025
Date: December 9, 2025
Purpose: To give written notice for the Approval of By-law(s) passed
at the December 9, 2025 Council Meeting

Under the authority of Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 284.11 (Veto Powers for By-laws);

The Mayor has decided as follows:

1. The Mayor will not exercise the power to veto the following By-laws, passed at the December 9, 2025, Council meeting:
 - By-law 103-25 being a by-law to amend the Comprehensive Zoning By-law No. 890-09, as amended for the Municipality of Leamington, which pertains to the subject lands ZBA 361, 918 and VL East of 918 Point Pelee Drive. (PLA-46-25)
 - By-law 104-25 being a by-law to deem part of a plan of subdivision not to be a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of Subsection 50(3) of the Planning Act. DB-01-25, 918 and VL East of 918 Point Pelee Drive. (PLA-46-25)
 - By-law 105-25 being a by-law to Amend By-law 35-18 to regulate certain matters related to cannabis
 - By-law 107-25 being a by-law to amend By-law No. 49-23 to Establish the Rules of Order and Procedures for Municipal Council and its Committees of the Municipality.
 - By-law 108-25 being a by-law to provide for the 2026 interim tax levy and to provide for the payment of taxes (FIN-26-25)
 - By-law 109-25 being a by-law to deem part of a plan of subdivision not to be a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of Section 50(3) of the Planning Act. (PLA 47-25)

- By-law 106-25 being a by-law to confirm the proceedings of the Council of the Municipality of Leamington at its meeting held December 9, 2025.
2. The Mayoral Direction/Decision provides written notice to approve the above by-law(s).
 3. This Mayoral Direction/Decision comes into effect December 9, 2025.
