Leamington Garbage Collection

- You will receive weekly garbage collection. Consult the maps provided here and on the municipal website at leamington.ca/garbage to determine your collection day. If you have questions regarding your garbage collection (i.e. what is acceptable) please call the Municipality at 519-326-5761.
- Place garbage out for collection, the night before, or no later than 6:00 a.m., on your collection day.
- **Unacceptable Garbage Containers:**
Do not place garbage out in containers that are:
 - Oversized & Overweight: Containers cannot weigh over 20 kg / 45 lbs.
 - Cut Up Plastic Barrels
 - Plastic Shopping Bags: Do NOT place them at the curb.
 - Cardboard Boxes: They are recyclable.
- **Large Items & Furniture:** A maximum of two large items will be picked up on your regularly scheduled garbage day (with the exception of white goods). Large items may include box springs, mattresses, carpets, toilets, chairs and similar materials.
- **Non-Collectable Waste:** Waste that is deemed non-collectable includes: Ammunition, animal carcasses, animal waste, appliances, automotive parts, bricks, combustibles, chemical waste, computer equipment, concrete, construction & demolition waste, explosives, industrial waste, liquid waste, medical waste, metal items, pallets, paint products, renovation debris, syringes, televisions, and tires. These items are not garbage and will NOT be collected – check index for Public Drop Off information.
- **Leamington Municipal By-Law 769-07** permits municipal staff to collect litter/junk/non-collectable materials from municipal properties, which have been placed curbside by residents that have not followed the proper collection guidelines. Owners of the property in contravention of the by-law will be charged a minimum of \$300.00. Residents are encouraged to use proper containers and follow weight restrictions for both garbage and yard waste.
- **Leamington Municipal By-Law 772-07** prohibits the depositing of litter on municipal lands or highways. If you should witness anyone littering municipal property or highways please contact the Municipality at 519-326-5761 or report it online at leamington.ca/reportanissue

- Never put sharp objects in plastic bags

Metal or Plastic Cans

- Maximum 125L / 30 gal. capacity
- Maximum 78 cm/31" tall, 20" diameter
- 2 handles and a water tight lid

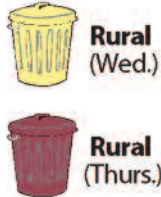

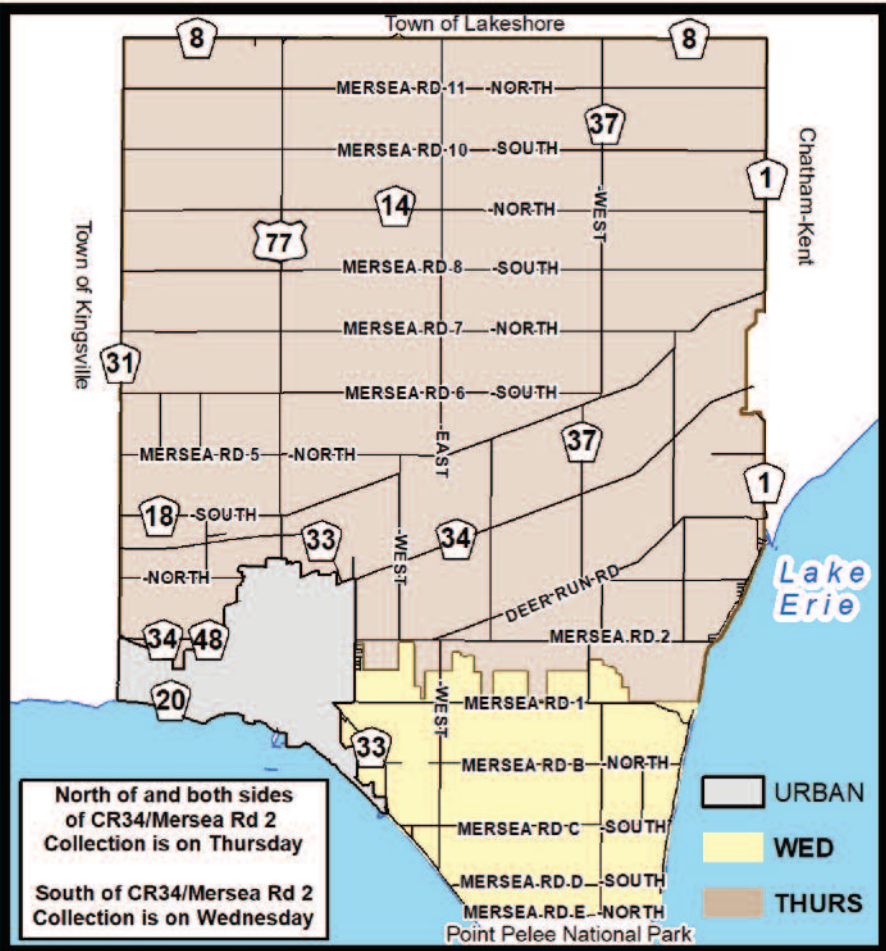


Rural Garbage Collection Map

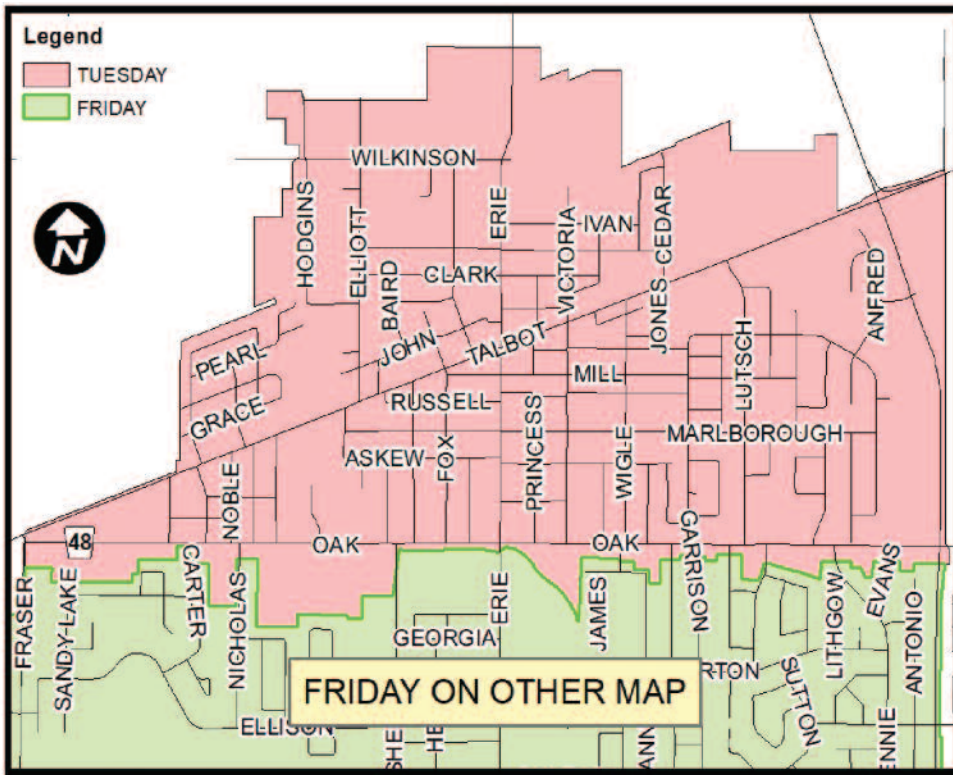

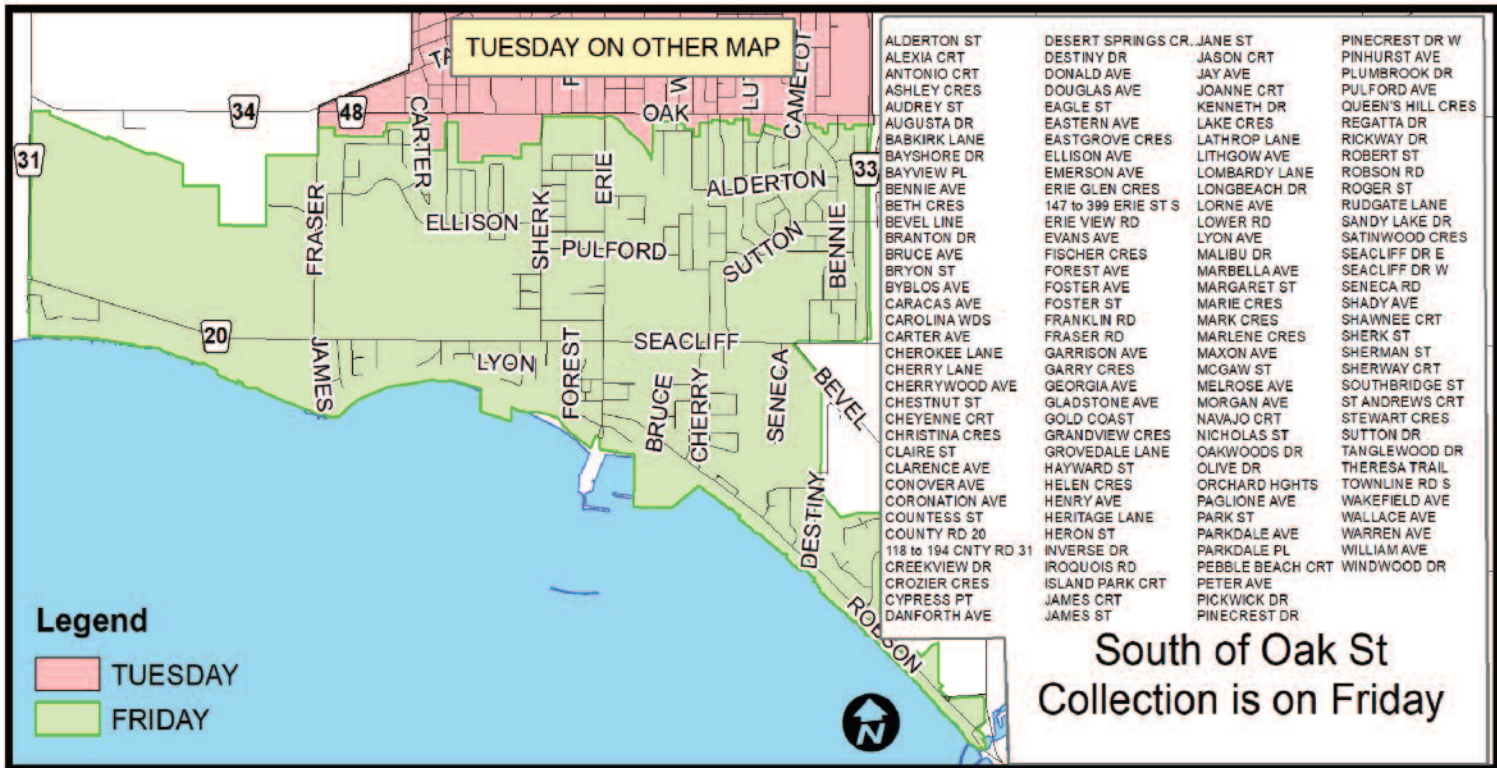

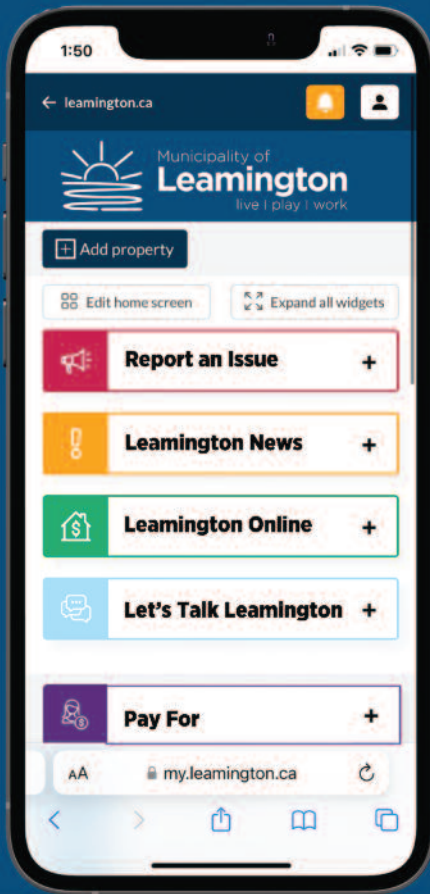

Yard Waste Collection

URBAN ONLY - Basic Collection Requirements:

- Yard Waste is defined as grass, leaves, garden trimmings, brush & branches.
- Yard Waste collection is every week, **April 10 through November 29, 2024**. Consult the map here and on the municipal website to determine your collection day. If you have any questions regarding your yard waste collection please call the Municipality at 519-326-5761.
- There is a **four bag / container limit** - 20 kg (45 lbs) per bag.
- The only **acceptable** containers are: Paper Yard Waste Bags, Cardboard Boxes, Garbage Cans / Pails.
- No **plastic bags** for yard waste (regular OR environmentally friendly).
- **No cut up plastic barrels.**
- **Christmas Trees:**
Christmas trees are run through a chipping machine and composted. All decorations, tree skirts, and plastic tree bags must be removed. Your Christmas tree collection dates are:

- January 2, 2025
- January 3, 2025
- January 6, 2025
- January 9, 2025



URBAN ONLY - Yard Waste Preparation:

Tree & Hedge Trimmings:

Tied in bundles (max. length 4ft. / max. diameter 2 ft.)

Garden Waste, Leaves, Grass Clippings:

Flowers, vegetables, plants, fruit, leaves and grass clippings should be put in cardboard boxes, paper yard waste bags, or garbage pails/cans.

During the month of November, Public Works will be picking up leaves from the boulevards as scheduled. To find out the leaf pick up dates for your area, please call the Municipality at 519-326-5761 or visit leamington.ca/garbage

Note: Do NOT sweep leaves from your property on to the street. This is **unlawful** and **dangerous**.

Large Trees & Shrubs: The Municipality no longer collects or chips residential **LARGE** trees or shrubs. Regular yard waste collection will take branches and brush up to approx. 3" in diameter, if cut and tied into bundles no larger than 4 ft by 2ft, and weighing less than 45 lbs. Larger items can be taken to the Public Drop Off Depot on Albuna Townline (see index for more information on the Public Drop Off Depot).

Branches and brush will be accepted on your yard waste day if they are bundled as follows:

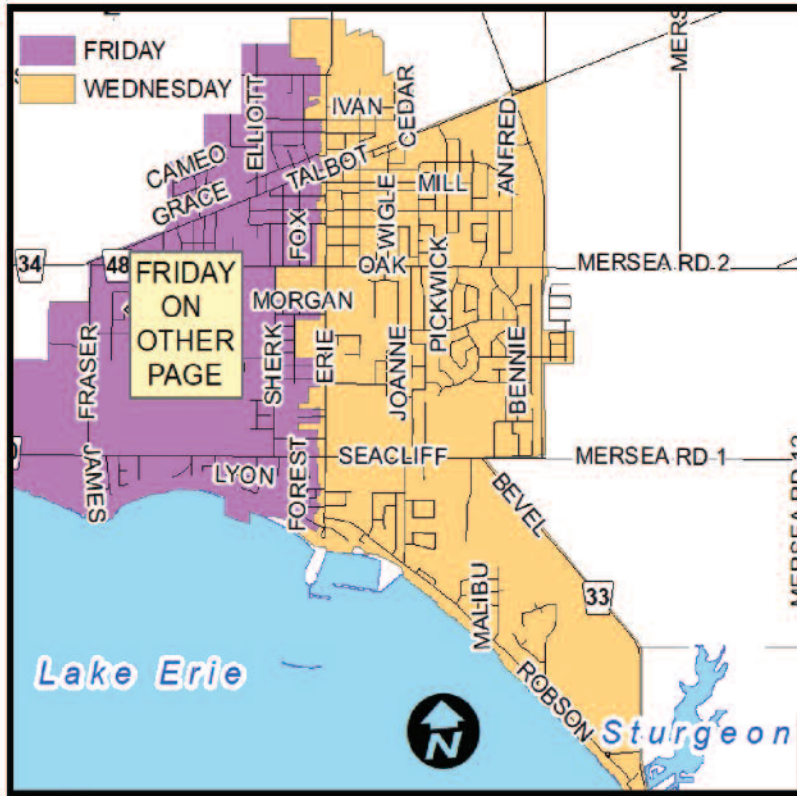
