**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LEAMINGTON**

**BY-LAW 592-05**

Being a by-law to permit the opening  
of Retail Business Establishments  
certain holidays.

**WHEREAS**, Section 4(1) of the Retail Business Holiday Act, R.S.O. 1990 c. R.30 as amended (hereinafter called the "Act") provides that a Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, permit retail business establishments in the municipality to be open on holidays for the maintenance of development of tourism;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipality held a Public Meeting on Monday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2005, notice of which was published in the Leamington Post, being a newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality, and at which persons in attendance were given the opportunity to make representations in respect of the proposed by-law;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipal Council of the Municipality of Leamington is satisfied that the tourism criteria as set out in the regulations of the Act have been met.

**NOW THEREFORE BY ITS COUNCIL THE MUNICIPALITY OF LEAMINGTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That notwithstanding Section 2 of the Act, all retail business establishments in the Municipality of Leamington carrying on business may be permitted to open on Victoria Day, Canada Day and Labour Day between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
2. That this by-law shall come into force and have effect on the 31<sup>st</sup> day from the passing thereof unless appealed to the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 4.3 of the Act.
3. By-law 4202-94, as amended, is hereby repealed.

# THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LEAMINGTON

## BY-LAW 678-06

Being a by-law to amend By-law No. 592-05, being a by-law to permit the opening of pharmacies on holidays listed in the Retail Business Holidays Act

**WHEREAS**, under Section 4(1) of the Retail Business Holiday Act, R.S.O. 1990 c. R.30 the Municipality of Leamington passed By-law No. 592-05, on May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2005, permitting businesses to remain open on Victoria Day, Canada Day and Labour Day between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Leamington realizes the importance of health care during the holidays;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Leamington deems it necessary to amend By-law No. 592-05 to permit all pharmacies to remain open during holidays outlined in the Retail Holidays Business Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipality held a Public Meeting on Monday, February 27<sup>th</sup>, 2006, notice of which was published in the Leamington Post, being a newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality, and at which persons in attendance were given the opportunity to make representations in respect of the proposed amendment;

**NOW THEREFORE BY ITS COUNCIL THE MUNICIPALITY OF LEAMINGTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Section 1 of By-law No. 592-05 be amended to read:

That notwithstanding Section 2 of the Act:

- a) all retail business establishments in the Municipality of Leamington carrying on business may be permitted to open on Victoria Day, Canada Day and Labour Day between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- b) all retail businesses in the Municipality whose pharmaceutical sales consisting of over 60 percent of their gross total sales be permitted to open 365 days a year.

2. That the Municipality of Leamington's By-law No. 592-05 is hereby amended.
